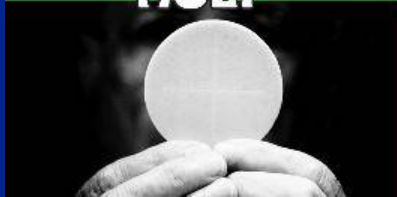

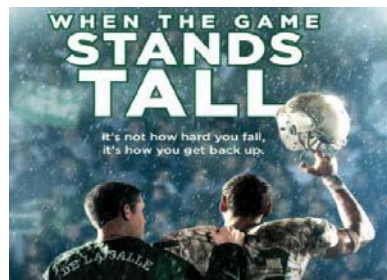

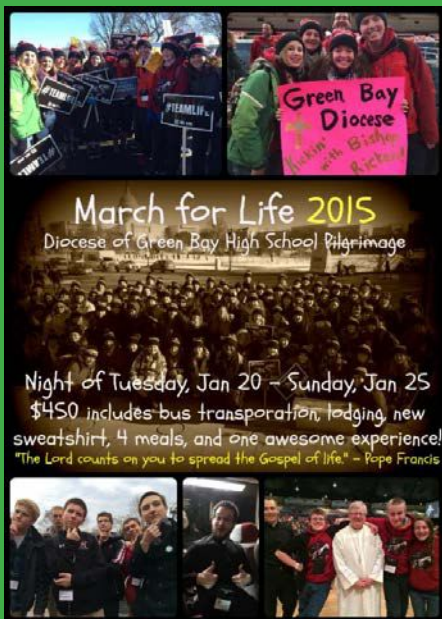

Pope Francis Advice on Prayer and Discernment

"Read the Beatitudes and then follow up with an examination of conscience, as you read Matthew, Chapter 25. Every day! You'll say, I did this and I did that. It's good for you. It's something simple, yet concrete."

"There are three vocations in people: to prepare, to discern and to allow the Lord to grow while diminishing oneself. It's also beautiful to think of a Christian vocation this way: A Christian doesn't need to announce him or herself. It's about announcing someone else. He paves the way for Someone else- the Lord. A Christian must know how to discern, must learn how to distinguish the truth from what seems true, but is not. To be a person of discernment. A Christian must be a person who knows how to make himself smaller so that the Lord grows, in the hearts and souls of others."

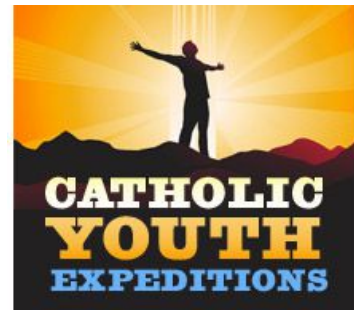
NCYC
