





Youth Ministry



In college, on my way to class - rather, **power** walking to catch my 8:30am class with sleepy eyes and a cup of hot chocolate or tea in hand, I often encountered an elderly Jesuit priest on campus who was well known by many of us students. He was blind and had been since his childhood. One of the

most hilarious men I had ever encountered (he was the king of one liners that would leave your insides hurting), Father would often be seen sitting on a bench on the main square taking in the campus and its students. I remember as the world was rushing around him (myself included), there was a peace about him. He was **radically available** to students and because of that, Father rarely found himself alone on the bench. Students would look forward to sitting next to him, taking a load off, and encountering that peace that throughout the day, was being replaced by other "necessary" chores, projects, research, work study, and quick lunches that wouldn't interfere with afternoon classes. Father knew radical availability. He lived it, and I often come back to him as the model for youth ministry. When was the last time I was available to anyone - having no alternative agendas, places to be, or projects to do? Have I really been truly open to the "**encuentros**" that occur

between God, myself, and the teenagers I work with? No time to be radically available, you say? Then as Bishop Ricken says, "**What do we need to stop doing? What do we need to start doing? What do we need to continue doing?**" God touches us in the "encuentro" moments - the encounter moments. How can we learn the art of being? Maybe it's by being who God calls us to be in our daily life choices, chores, time management, and work rather than being someone we are not and that is a big challenge set for all of us. However, it's something that our teens are yearning for - our attention and love that reflect the love of the Father.

Bishop wrote a prayer to help us with just that:

"Lord, help me to do your will.
Nothing more, nothing less.
Lord, help me to do your will.
Not a moment sooner.
Not a moment later.
Than You will it."

Pope Francis: It's Difficult to Listen to God's Voice When we are Self Centered (November Homily)

"All Christians, he continued, have this fear of God's generosity toward us, because many times, "we feel safer in our sins, in our limitations, but feel at home."

This fear, he noted, brings Christians to not answer God's invitation in order to not leave that safety net.

"Catholics, but not too Catholic," the Pope said. "Trusting in the Lord, but not too much. This 'but not too much' marks our lives, it belittles us."...

"Today, the Church asks us not to be afraid of the gratuitousness of God," he said. "Instead we must open our hearts, do our part as much as we can, because He will prepare the banquet."


