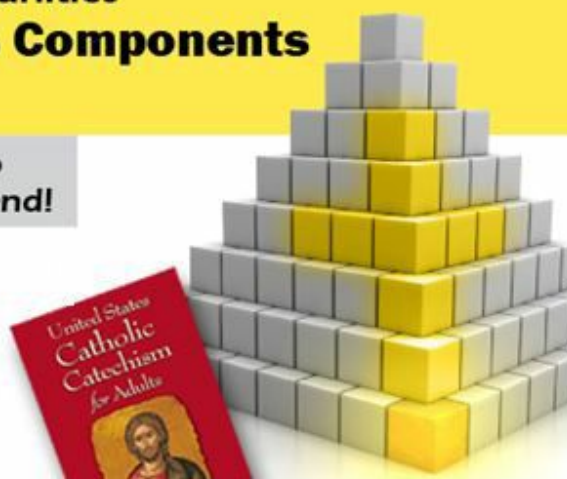

A Reminder about First Reconciliation Certificates

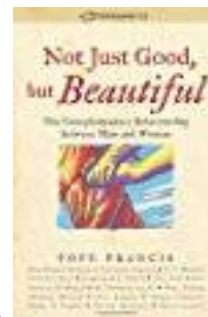
From Diocese of Green Bay Chancery Bulletin #334 (October 2010):

*"There have been reports that some parishes have issued certificates of first reconciliation to the children when they make their first confession. **While the intention may be to remember an important moment in the child's spiritual life and the gift of God's mercy, this practice does not respect the seal of confession**[emphasis added]. Only the priest and penitent know whether the penitent actually confessed any sins and whether absolution was then given. Thus, to "certify" that someone has in fact received the sacrament does not respect the integrity of the seal. This practice, if it still exists, must be discontinued. For this same reason, first reconciliation is not recorded in the parish's sacramental registers."*

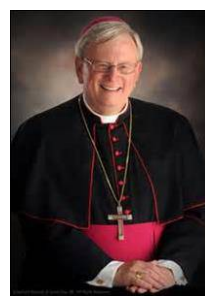

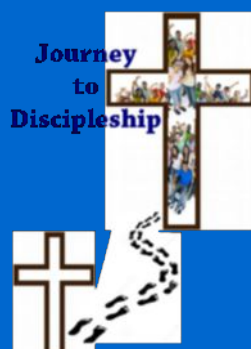
Essay Contest

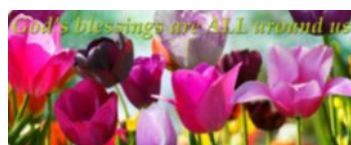
