to all RE/YM Leaders,

As you encourage employees/volunteers to support your upcoming RE and Youth Ministry Programs, as teachers, chaperones, prayer leaders, aides, etc., please keep in mind the diocesan Safe Environment Requirements. All employees (paid personnel regardless of position/job title) and all adult volunteers who have contact with minors as part of their volunteer duties are required to:

- 1) Have a Diocese of Green Bay approved background check,
- 2) Complete a VIRTUS "Protecting God's Children" Adult Awareness session,
- 3) Review and sign either the Our Promise to Protect (employees) or the Diocesan Code of Pastoral Conduct for Volunteers (volunteers).
