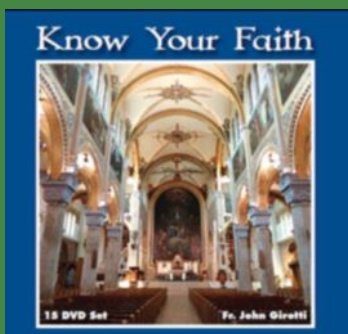

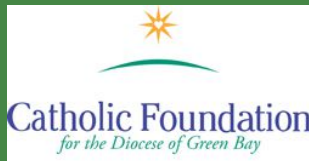

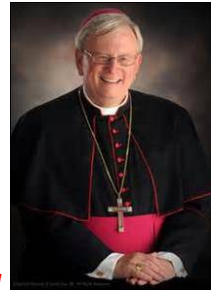

REGISTRATION:
