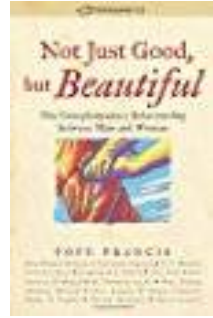

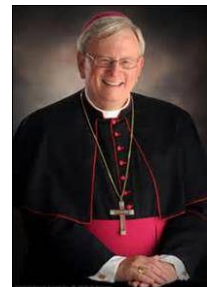

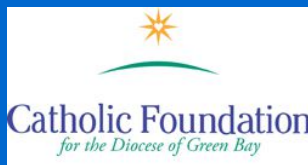
Sophia Institute will be presenting a two-day institute at St. Francis Xavier Conference Room on diocesan campus on June 14 and 15, 9am-3pm.

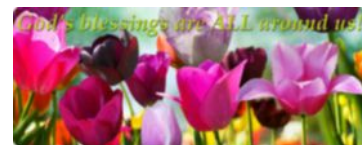
