St. Pope John Paul II Youth Scholarship

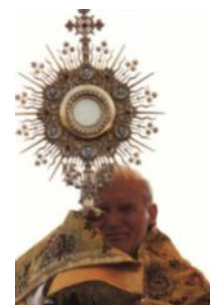
For High Schoolers
