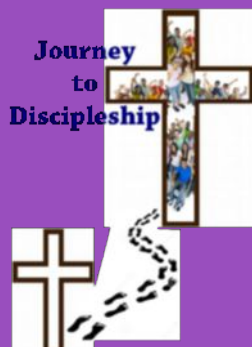
## Essay Contest

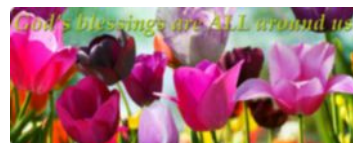

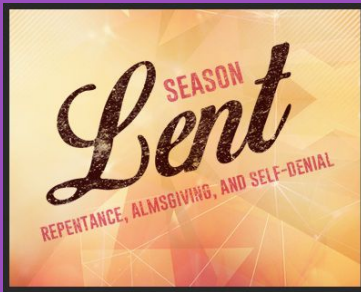
