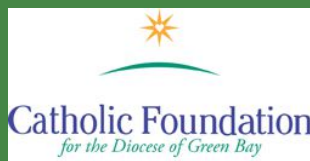
Regional Board In-Services

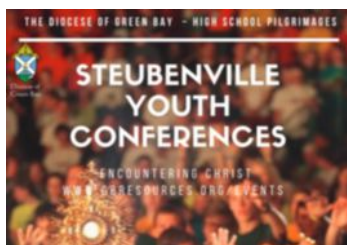

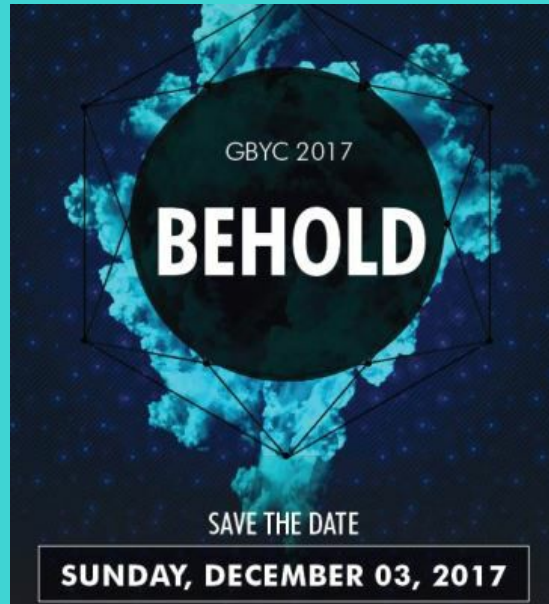
